Summary: To authorize imposition of a 1% local sales and services tax in the County of Marion, Iowa for school infrastructure projects for 10 years, from July 1, 2004 to June 30, 2014.

A local sales and services tax for school infrastructure projects shall be imposed in the County of Marion, Iowa at the rate of one percent (1%). The tax will begin in July 1, 2004. The tax will be in effect for a period of ten years until June 30, 2014.

The money received from the tax shall be spent for school infrastructure, including purchasing, building, furnishing, reconstructing, repairing, demolishing, improving, expanding, or remodeling of a schoolhouse or schoolhouses and additions thereto, gymnasium, stadium, field house, or school bus garage, purchasing and improving grounds, opening roads to school houses or buildings, the purchase lease or lease-purchase of buildings or equipment (including transportation and recreation equipment) as authorized by law, procuring or acquiring libraries, expenditures for energy conservation measures, the rental of facilities under Chapter 28E, the payment or retirement of bonds issued for school infrastructure purposes or the payment or retirement of bonds issued under Iowa Code Section 422 E. 4, for debt reduction or property tax relief, or for any one or more of such purposes, or for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law for those activities for which revenues under Iowa Code Section 300. 2 may be spent.
