# Public Measure

### SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Summary: To authorize imposition of a local sales and service tax in the City of Knoxville, at a rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from January 01, 2014 until December 31, 2023.

A local sales and service tax shall be imposed in the City of Knoxville, at a rate of one percent (1%) to be effective from January 01, 2014 until December 31, 2023.

Revenues from the sales and service tax shall be allocated as follows:

Zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.

The specific purpose for which the revenue shall otherwise be expended is: One hundred percent (100%) for the following public purposes, to-wit:

- 1.) Construction, maintenance and repair of infrastructure in the City of Knoxville, Iowa, to include streets, sidewalks, storm water control, sanitary sewers, bridges, downtown streetscape
- 2.) The purchase of capital equipment
- 3.) Building maintenance or expansion
- 4.) Land acquisition and site development determined by need or according to the City of Knoxville Comprehensive Plan
- 5.) Other community betterment projects or other lawful purposes in the City of Knoxville, Iowa as determined by resolution of the Knoxville City Council
