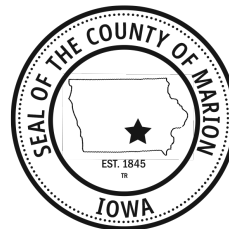

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Summary: To authorize imposition of a local sales and services tax in the unincorporated area of the County of Marion, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective on January 1, 2024.

A local sales and services tax shall be imposed in the unincorporated area of the County of Marion, at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective on January 1, 2024. Revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows: Fifty (50%) for property tax relief. The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are: Fifty percent (50%) for community betterment projects or other lawful purposes of the County of Marion, Iowa.
