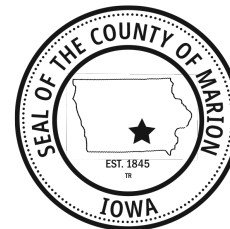

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

Shall the Board of Directors of the Pella Community School District in the Counties of Marion, Mahaska and Jasper, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$40,000,000 to provide funds to construct, furnish, and equip an Early Childhood Center and improve the site; to construct, furnish, and equip a classroom addition that connects Jefferson Intermediate and the Middle School buildings and to remodel, repair, improve, furnish and equip portions of Jefferson Intermediate and the Middle School buildings, and improve the parking; to improve and replace the HVAC system in the High School building, including the gymnasiums; and to improve, remodel, and repair the athletic stadium and baseball/softball fields and to improve those sites; and to construct new tennis courts?
